Caution: Turn off power to electrical box before installing

- 1. Carefully unpack parts. Install Mounting Bracket (A) onto Outlet box and secure with Machine Screws (B).
- 2. Connect the house supply ground wire to the fixture ground wire and secure with wirenut provided (D).
- 3. Connect the electrical leads from the fixture to the house supply wires, black to black and white to white, and secure with wirenuts provided (D).
- 4. Install Fixture Pan (E) to Mounting Bracket (A) by aligning opening in Fixture Pan to Threaded Nipple of the Mounting Bracket and securing it in place with Washer and Hex Nut (F). **NOTE**: There should be approximately 1/2" of Threaded Nipple extending past the Fixture Pan opening.
- 5. Install Glass (K) onto Fixture Pan (E) by loosening the Clips (G) and sliding the inner lips of the Glass underneath the Clips (G). Then tighten Clips (G) down to secure Glass (K) in place.
- 6. Install Lamps.
- 7. Install the Threaded Swivel and Washer (H) onto Threaded Nipple (I) of the Mounting Bracket, then install the Glass Shield (L) with the Decorative Cap (J).
- 8. Restore power. NOTE: Adjust Threaded Swivel accordingly until Glass Shield is straight. NOTE: Glass Shade is for instructional purposes. Actual Glass Shade may vary in size and shape.
